June 19, 2017

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Chair Arlon Rice called the meeting to order at 10:02 AM

2. Pledge of Allegiance and Roll Call of Board Members:

Present were Chair Arlon Rice, Treasurer Richard Mayer, Secretary Carole Ryan. Members at Large: Donna Gordon, Kevin O'Donnell. Chief Ben Palm and Safer Grant/Grant Specialist Denise Roggio in attendance.

3. Approval of Draft Minutes:

A. Richard made a motion to accept the Regular minutes for May 22, 2017 as reported. Kevin seconded. Motion carried by all.

4. Reports and Correspondence:

Richard presented: Profit and Loss, Budget vs Actual and Reconciliation Summaries

through the end of May, 2017.

General Fund: \$11,914.10

Donations and Grants: \$1,871.45

Capital Reserve Fund: \$1,428.44

Pension and Relief Fund: \$15,476.26

Yarnell Training Center: \$ 3, 224.05. This is non tax related money from our EMT

classes.

Wildland Fire: \$10, 359.67

Taxes received last month: 10,221.45 FDAT: \$1,531.03

Carole made a motion to accept this Treasurer's Report as stated. Arlon seconded.

D. Chief's Report: (see attached). Eight miles of fire abatement so far.

Memorial Run: It was discovered that our 19K race was 1 mile too long. And our 10K was ½ mile too short. 'My Map Room' had been used to calculate these distances. We will use

another calculation source next year. Gross funds raised of \$11,944.

Wild Fire deployments reported. We were able to take out our wild fire Ambulance (R-407) for the first time on the recent Lizard Fire. Gross income from this should be \$16,335.

E. **Safer Report and Grant Report:** (See both attached). No Cadet Grant so far. Denise will try others sources. We need \$8,000 for 2 more years which is used to pay our leader.

5. OLD BUSINESS:

6. NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Motion by Kevin to reimburse Denise Roggio for airfare and unpaid expenses up to \$450, to be taken out of donations and grants, for her trip to Atlanta in July to teach a grant writing class and speak about Yarnell Fire Department. Seconded by Carole. Motion carried by all.
- 2. The Chamber is asking for a fee reduction from \$100/month to \$25/month for use of the Admin Building as they only have coverage once/month. (See attached Weaver Mountain Chamber of Commerce report.)

We will continue this discussion at our July 2017 meeting.

- 3. Newly passed AZ Proposition 206 Minimum Wage- includes a requirement for paid sick leave. This does include sick leave for the Chief and the Captains. This does not include sick leave for stipend employees.
