D. Chief's Report: (See Attached) Verbal report by Cpt Carvahlo who is now a full time employee and EMS coordinator.

Final station extension plans sent to USDA. We will need 2 separate bathrooms- male/female. Del Webb Medical Center is now our medical director for EMT classes as well as Wickenburg Hospital. New air conditioning and new stand-alone generator have been installed in the station.

29 service calls in August. Mutual aid is not included in total calls.

E. Grant Report and Safer Report by Denise Roggio (see attached)

We have received \$20,959 of our USDA grant for new station a/c and generator. The total grant is \$77,600. They paid our attorney fees expended on this grant. We will be paying \$312/ month for the loan before the grant kicks in. \$22,441 left on the loan.

We have one contractor bid of \$49,000 for the station expansion. We need 1-2 more bids per USDA grant requirements.

Out of 10 grants applied for by Denise, we have been awarded 8, denied 1, with 1 still in progress.

SAFER: We will be using the second $\frac{1}{2}$ of this grant starting October 1, 2020. Denise asks for an average of \$7,000 every 5 weeks.

4. OLD BUSINESS:

Cpt Carvalho informed us that it would be a liability for WMHI to offer to provide services that we/they are not legally trained or certified to do.

C. Richard made a motion to approve the updated Board Policy #0019 Credit Card Usage. Dale seconded. Motion carried by all.

5. NEW BUSINESS:

A. The new VFIS policy will cost \$14,158 annually . We pay quarterly \$4,486. Carole made a motion to accept this renewal. Richard seconded, Motion carried by all. This policy insures the admin bldg, fire station, crew quarters and storage building and vehicles.

B. Richard made a motion to accept the awarded Fire Prevention and Safety Grant in the amount of \$31,190.48. Carole seconded. Motion carried by all.
